- 27 Holes—Teams will be divided by combined team handicap into specific flights
 - 6 teams per flight & will play five (9-hole) matches (3 on Sat./2 on Sun.)
 - All teams in the flight will play each other with stroke differential off low ball in the foursome.
 - Each 9-hole match will have points awarded:
Win Hole: 1 point }
Half Hole: ½ point } 10 points total per match
Win Match: 1 point }
- Most points for the day wins \$100*
- Hole-In-One Contest (all day)
 - 7:00 – 8:30 p.m.: Team Putting Championship Finals

- 18 Holes—(same match play as Friday)
- At the end of the tournament, all ties for the winner of each flight will be declared by their individual match during the tournament. If still tied, winner will be declared by a one-hole playoff (Hole #1) with strokes involved followed by a chip-off if still tied.
- After all flight winners are declared, there will be a “shootout” starting on Hole #1 (All strokes will be used as they fall using the tournament strokes given.) The “shootout” winners will be declared “Member-Member Champions”

Format

Points are awarded as follows: One point for winning the hole; ½ point for halving the hole, and one point for winning the match (10 total points per match). Teams playing against no-shows or dropouts will play their match against par (with a scorekeeper).

Flight winners are determined by the highest total points in each flight at the end of the five nine-hole matches. Tie breakers within the flight will be: 1st – who won the match against the other team; 2nd – play off on Hole #1. Flight runner-up is the team with the second highest total points in each flight at the end of the five nine-hole matches.

Shootout for Overall Winner

A shootout of all the flight winners will follow the last nine-hole match on Sunday. The winner of the shootout will be the overall champion. The shootout will start on Hole #1 and proceed until a winner is determined. The first flight winner will tee off first on Hole #1. The highest flight winner remaining will tee off first on Hole #2. On Hole #3, there will be a flip of a coin for honor. During the shootout, there will be a chip-off at the end of the hole if necessary. All teams tied for highest scores will chip from a predetermined spot. Teams will be eliminated by a “chip off” based on the number of flights determined by the pro. The remaining two teams will play off until a winner is declared.

Rules

This event must have partners who have handicap indexes within ten strokes of each other. U.S.G.A. and all local rules on scorecard apply. The golf professional and his staff will interpret the rules.

In case of inclement weather, the team with the most points through completed nine-hole matches will be flight winner. The overall winner will be decided by matching cards, instead of a shootout, using the last completed same nine-hole round for all flight winners.
